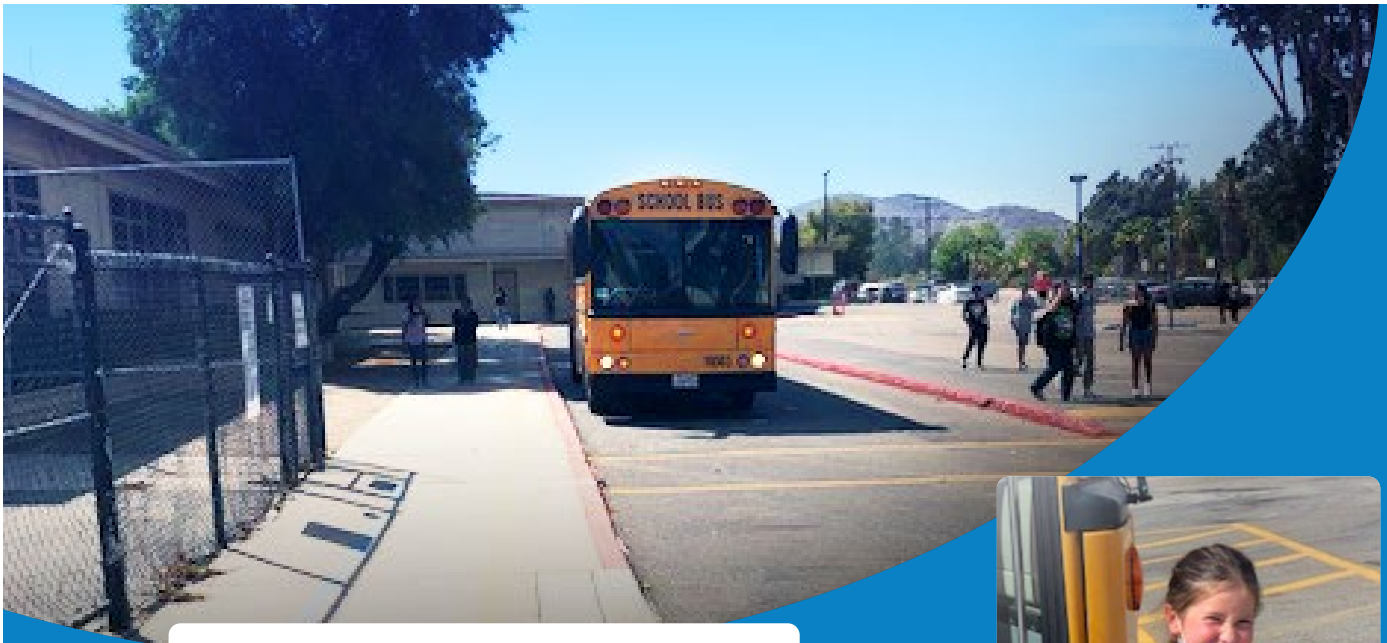
SUMMER PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT

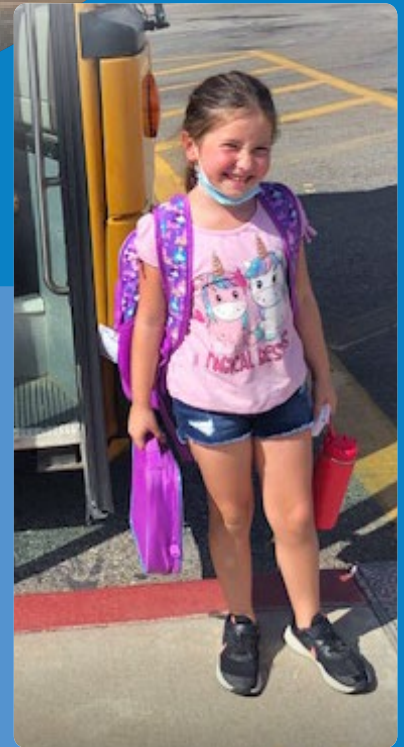

RIDE TO SUCCESS

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Inland Valley resumed its transportation program with the start of the 2021-2022 school year. The Club provides transportation from local schools to both the Menifee and Perris Clubhouses. This program is crucial for the many parents and families who are unable to pick up their children at their school's release time due to their job or other conflicting obligations. Many of our Club parents commute outside of the area and need a safe means of transportation for their child. That is where the Club steps in. This year presented extra challenges with the COVID-19 pandemic, but the Clubs remain committed to being able to provide this much-needed service for families. So far this year, 144 youth have enrolled in the program. When asked how the transportation program has helped provide parents with new opportunities, parents have expressed that it allowed them to take on new business, go to school, and remain in the workforce.
